LEARNING SUPPORT NEWS

We have a few items of interest that have to do with the 2018-2019 school year:

Updates for Medical Concerns/URIS Plans:

The medical forms to be updated will be sent out on **April 20th** by our secretary. It is important to have them returned by **April 26th**. If your child has an existing URIS plan, it will be sent to you to review and make changes during the week of **May 22nd - 25th**. The biggest change for this year is regarding the plans for children with asthma who are independent with their use of an inhaler. These plans no longer have to be sent home. Please advise the school if there is any change in the current plan. If your child is requiring a new plan for a newly diagnosed condition, we will send out the URIS B application form (2 sided pink form) and a questionnaire to fill out regarding your child's medical condition. The Unified Referral and Intake System (URIS) is a provincial program that supports children with special health care needs while attending school. Through URIS support, a registered nurse, together with the parent/guardian, develop an individual healthcare plan and/or emergency response plan for the student and trains the school staff on how to care for the student while they are at school. The parent/guardian must sign the completed health care plan and return it to the school in order for the plan to be used for the student while they are at school. The school no longer needs to submit URIS B applications for renewals. As a result, an annual review of health care plans and training can then be done to keep student information/health care needs and staff skills current. It is very important to return these forms as soon as possible. If there are no health concerns, we do keep a record of this in your child's cumulative file.

Welcoming Next School Year's Kindergarten Students:

The Kindergarten and Learning Support staff is excitedly waiting to meet the new Kindergarten students for the 2018-2019 school year. The Kindergarten Orientation meeting is scheduled for **Monday, May 14th, 2018 at 6:30 p.m.** Our Kindergarten Welcome Days are also that week. Your child will be scheduled for a one hour appointment either on **Wednesday, May 16th** or **Thursday, May 17th**. If you have registered your child for kindergarten but have not received a letter providing further details of the parent orientation meeting and your child's interview time by mail by April 20th please contact the school secretary Mrs. Benitez. If you know of any kindergarten students born in 2013 who have not registered yet, please encourage their parents to come to the school to do so as soon as possible. Intake meetings for kindergarten children who are foster children will be scheduled for mid April to mid May. We look forward to meeting you.
